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Anesthesia for a dental examination

After setting a date for a dental examination under anesthesia, we will need the following from you:

- 1) The parents of a child (under 18) acquire their pediatrician's **confirmation** of the child's state of health, no more than 14 days old. If the child is under specialist care (neurologist, cardiologist, endocrinologist, etc.), a confirmation from the pediatric specialist will also be required. Adults get a confirmation, no more than one month old, from their GP that they are fit to undergo anesthesia.
- 2) All patients/guardians **contact** the anesthesiologist, MUDr. Robert Šachl, by telephone (733 756 509) and agree on the next steps.
- 3) A completed anesthesiology **questionnaire**, handed over to the anesthesia team on the day of the procedure. You can certainly consult with your doctor at your discretion.
- 4) A **signed** informed consent form, handed over to the anesthesia team on the day of the procedure.
- 5) A **healthy** child or adult with no signs of infection on the day of the procedure.
- 6) Minimizing potential complications.
 - **All patients must arrive for their procedure on an empty stomach.** It is very important that no one eats for **six hours** before the procedure and no one drinks (up to 15 ml of sweetened tea, juice without pulp) for **four hours** before the procedure (milk and juice with pulp are considered food).

After anesthesia patients must remain under **constant supervision according to the anesthesiologist's instructions**. Patients must not perform any activities requiring focused attention that could result in injury, including playing (playground equipment, riding a bicycle) and must not consume alcohol or other drugs.
